Dear Ms. Eisenberg:

We are reviewing pre-application information submitted by the Kohler Company for authorization to discharge fill material into waters of the U.S. in connection with a proposed golf course development. The project is located in Section 11 and 14, T. 14 N., R. 23E. Sheboygan County, Wisconsin.

Enclosed is the completed *Request for SHPO Comment and Consultation on Federal Undertakings* for the proposed project. Due to the lack of a formal application at this time, the area of potential effect (APE) and permit area for the project are yet to be determine by this office. Once this office receives an application, an APE and permit area determination will be made.

Additionally, it was previously determined that site 47SB0173 was within the project area and needed further investigation. Commonwealth Cultural Resources Group concluded in their phase II archaeological survey (Phase II Archaeological Investigation 47SB0173) that this multi-component prehistoric/historic site to be eligible for the National Register of Historic Places under Criteria D. It is this office's determination that 47SB0173 as delineated is eligible. However, in regards to this proposed project, this office cannot make an effect determination until the applicant has provided the proposed project plans to our office.

Furthermore, this office understands that tribal consultation and additional analysis of the site may be required. This process will commence once the applicant submits a formal application.
